

AUDITOR'S CERTIFICATE IN CONNECTION WITH PAYMENT OF REDEMPTION AMOUNT TO THE NOTE HOLDERS OF K-ELECTRIC LIMITED SUKUK-4 (KE SUKUK-4)

K-Electric Limited (the Company) had issued, 4.4 million notes of K-Electric Sukuk-4 (KE SUKUK-4) amounting to Rs 5,000 each i.e., aggregate issue amount of Rs. 22,000 million, on September 14, 2015. The final book closure date from June 9, 2022 to June 17, 2022 (both days inclusive) in connection with the KE Sukuk-4 was communicated by the Company to Central Depository Company of Pakistan Limited (CDC) through letter dated May 17, 2022. The net redemption amount of Rs. 1,134 million has been paid to the note holders of KE Sukuk-4.

We have been requested by the management of the Company to provide the Company with a certificate on the annexed 'Statement of Redemption of K-Electric Sukuk-4 from the Central Depository System (CDS)' (the Statement), prepared by the management of the Company, which has been initialed by us for identification purposes only in connection with the payment of net redemption amount to the note holders of KE Sukuk-4 as referred to in the 'Procedures for Revocation of CDS Eligibility of Redeemable Securities' issued by CDC (here-in-after referred to as 'the Prescribed Procedures').

Scope of Certificate

The scope of the certificate is confirmation of payment of redemption amount of KE Sukuk-4 by the Company to the note holders as of the dates reflected in the annexed Statement after verification from the books and the bank statement of the Company.

Management Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the management of the Company to prepare the annexed Statement and provide us with the documents evidencing the compliance with the matters stated in the 'Scope of Certificate' paragraph above.

Auditor's responsibility

Our responsibility is to provide a certificate in connection with the matters as stated in the 'Scope of Certificate' paragraph in accordance with 'Guidelines for Issue of Certificate for Special Purposes by Practicing Chartered Accountant Firms' issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan. Our verification was limited to the following procedures:

- Obtained the Statement from the management of the Company giving details of the payment of the redemption amount made by the Company to the note holders of KE Sukuk-4;
- (ii) Obtained the copy of the register of note holders of KE Sukuk-4 received by the Company from CDC and checked the mathematical accuracy of the profit calculation on the outstanding principal amount of KE Sukuk-4;

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- (iii) Obtained on a sample basis details of the payment of the redemption amount made by the Company to the note holders of KE Sukuk-4, as of the dates reflected in the annexed Statement and traced the details of these payments aggregating to Rs. 1,134 million made from supporting documents i.e. copies of the Company's general ledger and bank statements and confirmation provided by the bank to the Company in respect of details of the note holders to whom payments were made;
- (iv) In relation to withholding of income tax, checked on a sample basis that the withholding tax is duly deducted as per Income Tax Ordinance, 2001 (ITO) from note holders except where:
 - (a) the note holder was plaintiff in Suit No. 2649 of 2022 filed before the High Court of Sindh; (b) the note holders were banking companies, on whom provisions of witholding tax are not applicable as per clause 5(2) of Seventh Schedule of the ITO; and (c) tax exemption certificates of the note holders were available with the Company; and
- (v) In relation to the amount Rs. 0.3 million withheld as income tax from note holders, checked that the amount has been deposited with government treasury.

Certificate

Based on the procedures mentioned above, we confirm that the payment of net redemption amount of Rs. 1,134 million after deducting withholding income tax therefrom aggregating to Rs. 0.3 million was made to the note holders of KE Sukuk-4 by the Company as of the date reflected in the annexed Statement.

Restriction on use and distribution

This certificate is issued by us in the capacity of statutory auditor of the Company on the specific request of the management of the Company and is not to be used for any other purpose or to be distributed to any party other than CDC and Pakistan Stock Exchange. This is with reference to your letter No. TR/CM/2022/PSX/406 dated May 17, 2022 announcing the final dates of book closure and subsequent PSX Notice No. N-549 dated June 09, 2022 on the subject.

You are requested to submit us the Auditor's Certificate confirming final redemption and profit payment of subject Sukuk enabling us to proceed in the matter of its delisting.
