		I have gone through the facts of the case, relevant provisions of the law and the record placed before me. Based on the aforesaid, it is evident that filling of annual return under Section 107 read with Regulation 5 of the Regulations is statutory requirement, that is required to be complied by listed companies in true letter and spirit. Moreover, the annual return is essential to determine, among others, particulars and summary of shareholding of each director, executive officer and substantial shareholder, their beneficial ownership and associated companies. It is undisputed fact that the Respondents have acknowledged delay in filing the annual return for the year 2020 as per requirements of Section 107 read with Regulation 5 of the Regulations and therefore the Respondents are liable under Section 106 of the Act. Taking cognizance of submissions of the Respondents and in terms of powers conferred under Section 106 of the Act, I hereby conclude this matter with warning to Respondents to ensure timely compliance of law in true letter and spirit in future.
6. Penalty	Imposed	Nothing in this Order may be deemed to prejudice the operation of any provision of the the Act providing for imposition of penalties in respect of any default, omission or violation of the Ordinance of the Act. Nil
