DADABHOY SACK LIMITED NOTES TO THE CONDENSED INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS (Un-Audited) For the Quarter Ended September 30, 2025

1 STATUS AND NATURE OF BUSINESS

1.1 The Company was incorporated on September 27, 1983 as a Private Limited Company by the name of Paper pro Industries (Private) Limited. The Company was converted into Public Limited Company on October 27, 1994 and its name was changed to Dadabhoy Sack Limited on January 19, 1995 under the repealed Companies Ordinance, 1984 (now the Companies Act, 2017). The principal activity of the Company is the manufacturing and sale of paper bags. In February 1996, the Company was listed at Stock Exchanges of Karachi and Lahore (now the Pakistan Stock Exchange Limited - PSX). The Company's registered office is situated at suite # 4, 2nd floor, plot no. 28-30/C, noor centre, Khayaban-e-Ittehad, Lane no.12, Phase VII, D.H.A., Karachi, Sindh. Manufacturing facility of the Company is located at Deh, Hatal Both, Thana Bula Khan, Main Super Highway, Jamshoro, Sindh.

Trading in shares of the Company was suspended by the Stock Exchanges on October 26, 2009 due to non compliances with respect to listing regulations.

1.2 Going Concern Assumption:

During the current period, the Company has incurred loss after taxation amounting to Rs. 0.679 million (September 30, 2024: Rs. 0.974 million) rising its accumulated losses to Rs. 40.044 million (June 30, 2025: 39.365 million). Further, current liabilities of the Company exceeded its current assets by Rs. 5.423 (June 30, 2025: 5.421 mllion). The operations of the Company were closed since financial year 2008 due to which the Company was facing financial and operational difficulties and was unable to discharge its liabilities in due course of business. The Company is reporting nil sales since then and is totally dependent on the financial support of its Directors.

The management of the Company has prepared these condensed interim financial statements on going concern basis due to the following reasons:

- a) The Company has revaluation surplus on fixed assets amounting to Rs. 27.591 million (June 30, 2025: 27.591 million) as on the balance sheet date, which is almost equivalent to the amount of accumulated losses of the company as stated above.
- b) The DSL is also seeking finance from external sources to fulfil the working capital requirements.

2 BASIS OF PREPARATION OF CONDENSED INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

2.1 Statement of compliance

These condensed interim financial statements of the Company for the quarter ended 30 September 2025 have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of International Accounting Standard 34 - "Interim Financial Reporting" and provisions of and directives issued under the Companies Act, 2017. In case where requirements differ, the provisions of or directives issued under the Companies Act, 2017 have been followed. The disclosures in the condensed interim financial statements do not include the information reported for full annual financial statements and should therefore be read in conjunction with the financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2025. Comparative statement of financial position is extracted from annual financial statements as of 30 June 2025 whereas comparative condensed interim profit or loss, condensed interim statement of comprehensive income, condensed interim cash flow statement and condensed interim statement of changes in equity are extracted from unaudited condensed interim financial statements for the quarter ended 30 September 2025.

3 SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND ESTIMATES

The accounting policies and the methods of computation adopted in preparation of these condensed interim financial statements are the same as those applied in preparation of annual financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2025.

The preparation of these condensed interim financial statements in conformity with the approved accounting standards, as applicable in Pakistan, requires management to make judgments, estimates and assumptions that affect the application of policies and the reported amounts of assets, liabilities, income and expenses.

The estimates and associated assumptions are based on historical experience and various other factors that are believed to be reasonable under the circumstances, the results of which form the basis of making the judgments about the carrying values of assets and liabilities that are not readily apparent from other sources. Actual results may differ from these estimates.

The estimates and judgements applied by the management in preparation of these condensed interim financial statements is same as those applied in preparation of annual financial statements of the Company for the year ended 30 June 2025.
