#### **DIRECTORS' REVIEW**

The Directors are pleased to announce the results of the Company for the guarter ended September 30, 2019.

#### **Industry Review**

During the first quarter, the overall domestic sales in south market have shown steep declining trend and reduced by approximately 32% as compared to same period last year owing to prevailing uncertain conditions in real estate sector in post budget environment and liquidity crunch due to lack of investors' confidence. However, on export front, due to higher exports of clinker the overall market showed a healthy growth of 27%. Net overall dispatches in the south region, however decreased by 11% as compared to same period last year.

#### Sales Review

During the quarter under review, the overall cement dispatches of the company reduced by 180,051 tones (27%). Local cement sales declined by 204,332 tons (41%), however, the export of cement increased by 24,281 tons (15%) as compared to same period last year.

The main reason behind significant reduction in local cement sale was due to arrival of new cement plant / additional expansion in South and slow down in demand.

On the back of high production, the company continued to export clinker in the markets of Bangladesh, Africa and Sri Lanka and during the quarter under review your company exported 276,987 tons showing a marginal decline of 6%. This decline is mostly attributable to stiff competition amongst local and regional capacities and seasonal effects of monsoon in Bangladesh.

#### **Financial Review**

The net sales revenue of the company decreased by Rs. 712 million (13%) over corresponding period due to lower dispatches as compared to same period last year. Though the overall net retention (both cement & clinker) increased by Rs. 629 per ton (11%) primarily due to better sales mix and also due to significant devaluation of PKR against US dollar resulting improved export proceeds.

On the other side of equation, the production cost per ton has shown an increase of Rs.161 per ton (3%). Even though, coal prices in the international market has been reduced by almost 40% as compared to same period last year, however said reduction in prices was partially offset against the devaluation of PKR against US dollar. Similarly all other major input cost elements like paper bags, raw material cost, diesel etc increased significantly due to higher inflation.

Due to better net retention, both the gross and operating margins improved from 21% and 11% to 26% and 13% respectively and the company recorded net profit after tax of Rs. 358 million.

#### **Future Outlook**

The country is facing serious economic and financial challenges which have significantly affected the overall performance of the large scale manufacturing sector and cement is no exception. Abnormally high devaluation, significant increase in interest rates, and uncertain geo-political conditions have affected the investors' confidence.

Besides above, the domestic cement demand have slowed down during 1Q FY20 as government spending dried up and private sector development halted due to strict tax reforms measures taken by the government.

This coupled with additional new capacities of around 9.8 million tons which are coming in next 12-18 months may put pressure on the pricing equilibrium both in local and export markets. In order to improve the profitability, the company is exploring various markets and cost saving projects.

Your management is evaluating all the options and trying its level best to keep the momentum going. The immediate target of the company is to ensure 100% sales either in the form of cement or clinker from all its 3 production lines by exploring all segments of both local and export markets.

#### 1 THE COMPANY AND ITS OPERATIONS

1.1 The company was incorporated in Pakistan on October 14, 1981 as a public limited company and is listed on Pakistan Stock Exchange. Its main business activity is manufacturing and sale of cement. The registered office of the company is at D-70, Block-4, Kehkashan-5, Clifton, Karachi. The company's cement manufacturing plant is located in Tehsil Hub, District Lasbella, Balochistan. The company also has a representative / liaison office in Dubai, UAE, to explore business opportunities in the growing markets of Middle East and Africa.

The company is a subsidiary of Pharaon Investment Group Limited Holding S.A.L., Lebanon.

1.2 The company had entered into a Joint Venture agreement with Al-Geetan Commercial Agencies, Iraq, to form a limited liability company in Iraq. The principal activity of the company will be to build and operate a cement grinding plant having production capacity of approximately 900,000 metric tons per annum. The new limited liability company has been established and registered under the Iraqi law on November 3, 2014 by the name Saqr Al-Keetan for Cement Production Company Limited having share capital of 30,000,000 Iraqi Dinar. Attock Cement Pakistan Limited will hold 60% share in the company. Moreover, subsequent to approval from SBP Company has remitted US\$ 16.3 million (approx) to Iraq. Equity investment in subsidiary company has been approved by the members in its Extra Ordinary General Meeting held on May 12, 2015 as was required under section 208 of the repealed Companies Ordinance, 1984. The Company has started commercial production from September 01, 2019.

#### 2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The accounting policies adopted in the preparation of this condensed interim financial information are the same as those applied in the preparation of the preceding annual financial statements of the Company for the year ended June 30, 2019.

#### 3 BASIS OF PRESENTATION

This condensed interim unconsolidated financial information of the Company for the quarter ended September 30, 2019 has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the International Accounting Standard (IAS) 34, 'Interim Financial Reporting' and provisions of and directives issued under the Companies Act, 2017. In case where requirements differ, the provisions of or directives issued under the Companies Act, 2017 have been followed. This condensed interim financial information is being posted on Company's Website for information of members as required by section 237 of the Companies Act, 2017 and the Listing Regulations of the Pakistan Stock Exchange.

This condensed interim financial information does not include all the information required for full financial statements and should be read in conjunction with the annual financial statements for the year ended June 30, 2019.

#### 1 THE GROUP AND ITS OPERATIONS

#### 1.1 The group consists of:

#### Holding Company - Attock Cement Pakistan Limited (the "Company")

The company was incorporated in Pakistan on October 14, 1981 as a public limited company and is listed on Pakistan Stock Exchange. Its main business activity is manufacturing and sale of cement.

Pharaon Investment Group Limited Holding S.A.L., Lebanon is the ultimate holding company as it holds 84.06% of the total paid-up share capital of the company.

The geographical locations and addresses of the Holding Company's business units, including mills / plant are as under:

- The registered office of the Holding Company is at D-70, Block-4, Kehkashan-5, Clifton, Karachi.
- The Holding Company's cement manufacturing plant is located in Tehsil Hub, District Lasbella, Balochistan.
- The Holding Company also has a representative / liaison office at Plot No. 581-0, Arzoo Building, Al Mararr, Dubai, UAE.

#### Subsidiary Company - Sagr Al-Keetan for Cement Production Company Limited (SAKCPCL)

SAKCPCL was incorporated under Iraqi law on November 3, 2014. Its main business activity is manufacturing and sale of cement and the principal place of business is in Iraq.

The geographical locations and addresses of the Subsidiary's business units, including mills / plant are as under:

- The registered office of SAKCPCL is at House # 35, Square 29, Near Al Buradia Super Market, Al Rbeea District Al Buradia, Basra, Iraq.
- SAKCPCL's cement manufacturing plant is located in Industrial Sector, Land No. 1/7, Sector 56, Al-Arquli Al Janobi, Khor Al-Zubair, Basra, Iraq.

#### 2 SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of these consolidated financial statements are the same as those applied in the preparation of the preceding annual financial statements of the company for the year ended June 30, 2019.

#### 3 BASIS OF PREPARATION

This condensed interim financial information of the Company for the quarter ended September 30, 2019 has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the International Accounting Standard (IAS) 34, 'Interim Financial Reporting' and provisions of and directives issued under the Companies Act, 2017. 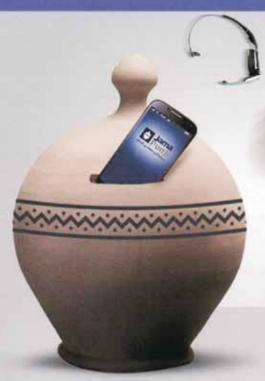
