Mayor urges govt to announce package for daily wagers

Mayor Wasim Akhtar has demanded of the Sindh Government to immediately announce package for daily wagers who are facing hardships to feed their families during the lockdown.

Talking to a delegation of All City Tajir Ittehad here, Wasim Akhtar said that the Karachi Metropolitan Corporation has decided to defer to take rent from tenants of 7500 shops in 43 KMC markets, adding that the same would be charged in four-month instalment, said a statement on Monday.

The delegation was led by Chairman All City Tajir Ittehad Hakeem Shah while KMC Senior Director Coordination Musadd Ahmed, Director Finance Muhammad Inam, Director Anti Encroachment Bashir Siddiqui and other officials were also present on the occasion.

The Mayor said that KMC can around Rs 80 million per year from shops' rent and the amount is spent on renovation and uplift of markets. The delegation hailed Mayor for deferring

the rent and taking it in instalments. Wasim Akhtar said that small traders and daily wagers are finding it very difficult to feed their families and if the situation persists, it may have more impacts than coronavirus.

He added that he considered the traders' demands rightful and asked the government to take practical steps for them.

He feared that if the situation continues, three million people would be rendered jobless and 10 percent more population of the country would go below poverty line.

The business used to be at peak on the eve Ramadan and Eid-ul-Fitr also shopping a major blow. Online shopping could be effected during lockdown but in Pakistan billions of people are unaware of online shopping," he added. Speaking about COVID19, Wasim Akhtar said that World Health Organization and experts have warned that month of May could prove difficult and prevention is the best way to stop further spread of novel coronavirus.

Nasir wants end to propaganda against frontline heroes

Sindh Minister for Information, Local Government, Housing & Town Planning, Religious Affairs, Forest and Wildlife Syed Nasir Hussain Shah on Tuesday visited the Jinnah Hospital and inquired about the well-being of the patients admitted there.

The minister made the visit to Jinnah Hospital on the orders of Sindh Chief Minister Syed Murad Ali Shah after a defamatory video about Jinnah Hospital went viral. During his visit, he inquired about the well-being of the patients and the treatment being provided to them.

Speaking on the occasion, Shah said that all of us were going through a very difficult time, adding that in these testing times, our doctors, nurses and paramedical staff were working like front line heroes.

The provincial Information Minister said that it was extremely inappropriate to criticize the people associated with the medical field at a time when the whole country was facing a pandemic like Coronavirus. Talking about the

viral video, he said that through such negative tactics, few miscreants were trying to discredit the medical staff, the government and those who were assisting the people in the time of pandemic.

He said that at this moment in time there was a need to encourage our doctors, nurses and paramedical staff, rather than spreading negative propaganda against them.

"We must not harass or discourage our medical staff," he said. Shah further said that Sindh government was providing all safety equipment to its doctors, nurses and paramedical staff. The minister said that the Sindh government was very much concerned about its doctors, nurses and paramedical staff and would help them in any way possible.

He also praised the management of the hospital for their work in caring for the patients.

286 stranded Pakistanis arrive from Dubai

The repatriation of Pakistanis stranded in the United Arab Emirates (UAE) continues as 286 more people stranded in Dubai landed at Karachi airport. The special flight of Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) flew 286 people back to Karachi on Tuesday evening.

Upon landing at the Karachi airport, the flight was disinfected and the passengers went through a screening process and later were shifted to the quarantine facility.

All the passengers and crew members have for now been quarantined at a local hotel. PIA on Sunday announced to operate 21 more special flights from May 1 to 10 to repatriate stranded Pakistanis from

the UAE. Out of the total 21, some 15 flights will be operated by the Pakistan International Airlines (PIA) while six flights will be handled by the UAE-based airlines.

More than 4000 passengers will be able to travel on these special flights. Earlier in the Day, a flight of the Sri Lankan Airlines with 30 stranded Pakistanis on board landed at the Karachi International Airport. The passengers were disinfected by the staff of the Civil Aviation Authority upon landing. The passengers were screened and later were sent to the quarantine facility as a precautionary measure amid coronavirus outbreak. The flight will return back to Colombo after taking back the Lankan citizens stranded in Pakistan.
