# Hardened criminals: Sindh govt decides to introduce electronic-tagging bill

**RECORDED REPORT**

KARACHI: Sindh Chief Minister Syed Murad Ali Shah, presiding over a meeting to work out a strategy to combat crime in view of the emergency, decided to legislate an electronic tagging (E-tagging) of criminals involved in repeated crime and decided to start targeted operations against the miscreants.

The meeting was held at CM House on Monday evening and was attended by Advisor to the CM on Law, Justice Waheed, Chief Secretary Mumtaz Shah, Advocate General Salman Talibdin, IG Police Mustaq Maher, Home Secretary Saeed Mangnejo, Additional IG Karachi Ghulam Nabi Memon, Additional IG Special Branch Javed Qadri, Deputy DC, Rangers Brigadier Asif Saeed, Secretary Law Ali Ahmad Baloch, DIGs and heads of intelligence agencies.

Shah said that there were a number of criminals who were habitual. "I want electronic tagging of such criminals to be made so that close eye could be kept on them."

The Electronic tagging is a system in which a criminal or suspected criminal has an electronic device attached to them which enables the police to know if they leave a particular area.
