Reference is made to the application of M/s. - 3. Furthermore, the Company is also directed to furnish within a week from date of holding of AGM, a Compliance report along with attested copies of minutes of the said meeting to this office.
- 4. This letter is issued without prejudice to any action that the Commission may initiate for non-compliance of any requirements of the Act.
