Governor Tessori announces free solar panels

GOVERNOR REPORT

Sindh Governor Kamran Tessori has announced free solar panels for low-income families in effort to provide relief from load shedding.

Speaking to journalists here, Tessori said households consuming up to 300 units of electricity, with a rent agreement and children under 10 years old, will be provided with free solar panels. Sindh Governor said this initiative will free citizens from the "misery of load shedding" and was made possible through the generosity of overseas Pakistanis.

He assured that the solar panels will be provided free of cost, and households can use up to 300 units of electricity without any charges. "No charges will be taken for installing solar," he added.

Moreover, Kamran Tessori announced that ration bags would be distributed from the Governor's House on Eid day, and 20,000 families were set to benefit. He also announced the launch of a free medical treatment and medicine programme after Eid.

Highlighting his initiatives for the Karachi citizens, he said that thousands of people have benefited from IT courses, and motorcycles were being distributed to those whose bikes were stolen. Nearly, 8,000 students have received Laptops, and assistance has been provided to women and children, he added. The Governor expressed his commitment to providing job opportunities for youth and announced the establishment of a Governor's Job Portal. After Eidul Adha, he said a free six-language course will be offered at the Governor's House, and a program will be launched to facilitate visas and jobs for young people.

Hamdard Shura hails govt to privatize state-owned enterprises

The members of the Hamdard Shura Karachi chapter welcomed the decision of the federal government to privatize state-owned enterprises and expressed hope that the process of selling national assets would be handled transparently and effectively. They expressed their views in the monthly meeting of Hamdard Shura held yesterday at Hamdard Corporate Head Office on the topic "Privatization of state-owned enterprises and the future of laid-off employees".

Speaker Gen (r) Moimuddin Haider presided over the proceedings. Ms Sadia Rashid, President of Hamdard Foundation Pakistan also attended the meeting. Speaking on the occasion, Gen (r) Moimuddin Haider

said the major reasons for the failure of state-owned enterprises are overstaffing and the country's overall economic conditions. "Unfortunately, Pakistan has never been able to attract constant foreign direct investments in various sectors, resulting in a lack of employment opportunities. This caused overstaffing of the existing state-owned corporations and companies," he said. He also said present economic challenges compelled the government to reduce its expenses and privatize around 25 SOEs with management rights. The increase in direct and indirect taxes has negatively impacted the purchasing power of ordinary citizens. The nation has been suffering the consequences of decades of mismanagement and corruption in state

Senior journalist Ishaq Mangrio passes away

Senior journalist of Sindh media and former president Hyderabad Press Club Ishaq Mangrio passed away here on Sunday. He was 65. Ishaq Mangrio was under treatment at Dow University Hospital for the last several days but could not survive. He was one of the best investigative journalist and served in different Sindh dailies and TV media outlets.

According to family sources Magrio's body is being shifted to ancestral village Gul Hassan Sirewal in district Sanghar and will be laid to rest there at his ancestral graveyard. Meanwhile, Sindh Chief Minister Syed Murad Ali Shah expressed deep grief and sorrow over the demise of journalist Ishaq Mangrio.

According to statement issued from the CM House, Syed Murad Ali Shah said that Ishaq Mangrio was a nice investigative journalist who had also filed special reports on environment.

The contribution of late journalist in journalistic field will always be remembered. CM said and added that Sindh Government was already bearing all his treatment expenses and Information Minister Sharjeel Memon was in contact with the family of the deceased during his admission in Dow University hospital. Ishaq Mangrio was under treatment at Dow University Hospital for the last several days but could not survive. The chief minister also expressed condolence to the bereaved family and prayed for the departed soul to be in eternal peace.

PTI Sindh chief seeks Rs500b for Karachi uplift

Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) Sindh President and former Opposition Leader in Sindh, Haleem Adil Sheikh, addressed an important press conference at Insaf House Karachi. PTI leaders Faheem Khan, Jamal Siddiqui, MPA Shabbir Qureshi, Sarbuland Khan, Adab Jahangir, Arslan Khalid, Agha Arslan, Advocate Zahoore Mubsood, Mansoor Shahid and others were present in press conference. Mr Sheikh highlighted that over the past 15 years, the Sindh government has received a budget of Rs 12,633 billion, with more than Rs 3,000 billion allocated for 2024-2025, yet there has been no development in Sindh.

The people of Sindh lack basic amenities. Sheikh stated that corruption amounting to Rs 1,650 billion has been recorded through various sources over the past 15 years, including over Rs 850 billion in development budget corruption.

He mentioned that during the current fiscal year, the Sindh government's domestic and foreign debt has reached Rs 1,341 billion, with a 26% increase during 2023-24 and an addition of Rs 325 billion in new loans. Sheikh criticized the state of Sindh's forests, which have been destroyed, with 2.8 million acres under encroachment, and no projects to plant trees.

While the world is saving forests, the Sindh government is cutting them down. Regarding education, Sheikh revealed that Rs 1,920 billion has been allocated over 15 years, with Rs 454 billion allocated for 2024-25. Despite this, 6 million children are out of school, with no books or uniforms, and over 12,000 schools closed. More than 26,000 schools lack drinking water, 19,000 schools have no toilets, 31,000 schools are without electricity, 21,900 schools lack boundary walls, 36,000 schools have no playgrounds, and 47,000 schools have no laboratories. He also pointed out the issue of ghost teachers and schools turned into cattle pens or guest houses. Scholarships for deserving children and free textbook distribution are marred by corruption.

Sindh's education standards are the worst in Pakistan, with the education department embroiled in a Rs 3 billion desk scandal. He noted that from 2008 to 2024, education department projects remain incomplete, including Education City, boarding school schemes, cadet school projects, engineering colleges, divisional level girls' public schools, Zulfiar Ali Bhutto Law College, Asifa Bhutto Institute of Electronics, Mirpurkhas and Hala medical colleges, and many more. Despite an increase in the number of teachers and the budget, educational standards have not improved. Digital libraries in 48 colleges, transport facilities in rural colleges, and the census scheme for private schools and madrassas remain incomplete. In healthcare, Sheikh pointed out that Rs 1,144b has been allocated over 15 years, with Rs 300b for 2024-2025. Yet, hospitals lack ambulances and medicines, functioning more as referral centers. There are no burn wards outside Karachi, an increase in AIDS cases, dog bite incidents without anti-rabies vaccines, and a non-functional health care commission. Q
