Murad intensifies efforts against poliovirus resurgence

RECORDER REPORT KARACHI: The Polio Oversight Board (POB), the highest decision-making body of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI), met with Sindh Chief Minister Syed Murad Ali Shah at the Chief Minister's House to review and discuss the province's progress in eradicating polio.

Led by Chair Dr Chris Elias, the POB commended the Sindh government's unwavering commitment to combating polio despite significant challenges. The meeting included high-profile representatives from international and provincial organisations, such as Dr Hanan Balkhy (WHO Regional Director), Sanjay Wijesekera (UNICEF Regional Director), Aziz Memon (Trustee of the Rotary Foundation), and officials from the US CDC and the King Salman Humanitarian Aid and Relief Centre (KS Relief).

From the government side Health Minister Dr Azra Fazal Pechuho, Sindh Chief Secretary Asif Hyder Shah, Mayor of Karachi Muratza Wahab, provincial secretaries and Coordinator EOC Irshad Sodhar and other senior officials attended the meeting. The Chief Minister highlighted Sindh's intensified efforts to address the resurgence of wild poliovirus type 1 (WPV1), with 13 cases reported this year following 34 months without any cases.

"We have mobilised 4,500 additional staff, engaged parliamentarians in areas with high refusal rates, and achieved a 50pc reduction in persistent refusals," he stated. He also noted that frontline workers, supported by 20,000 police personnel, successfully vaccinated over 10.6 million children in recent campaigns.

The Sindh government's recent immunisation drives reported Local Quality Assessment Survey (LQAS) pass rates of 89 per cent in September and 84 per cent in October.

The Chief Minister emphasised the importance of combating vaccine hesitancy through targeted communication strategies and expressed gratitude to global partners, including the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and Rotary International, for their ongoing support. POB Chair Dr Chris Elias praised Sindh's efforts, saying, "Sindh has made substantial progress, and we are confident that the teams will successfully clear the environment of the virus."

He also acknowledged the unique challenges faced by Karachi, including high population density and community mobility, which complicate efforts to eliminate the virus. Dr Azra Fazal Pechuho reaffirmed Sindh's commitment to closing immunity gaps, particularly in high-risk areas like Karachi. "With the steadfast support of the Sindh government and our global partners, we are determined to protect every child and eliminate polio from the province," she stated.

Chief Secretary Asif Hyder Shah highlighted the role of government support teams in assisting frontline workers and engaging communities to ensure smooth vaccination campaigns. The delegation also acknowledged Sindh's implementation of performance evaluation scorecards and a transparent accountability framework to enhance campaign efficiency.

Preparations begin to reclaim occupied lands of transport dept

RECORDER REPORT KARACHI: The Sindh government has begun preparations to reclaim the lands belonging to the transport department. It has been decided to seek the assistance of the Chief Secretary Sindh, IG Sindh, and the anti-encroachment authorities to carry out the process.

As per details, the 13th meeting of the Sindh Mass Transit Authority Board was held in Karachi, chaired by Sindh Senior Minister Sharjeel Inam Memon. Speaking at the meeting, Memon stated that in the 12th meeting of the Sindh Mass Transit Authority Board, it was decided to reclaim the occupied lands of the transport department. He emphasised that the removal of illegal occupations on these lands should be ensured as soon as possible, with the support of the Chief Secretary Sindh, IG Sindh, and anti-encroachment authorities.

He said that notices have been issued for the lands on which the offices of government institutions have been constructed. Negotiations should be conducted with the relevant institutions to ensure compliance with these notices. In the minutes of the 12th meeting of the Sindh Mass Transit Authority Board, the appointment of the Secretary of the Board for the Sindh Mass Transit Authority was approved.

PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING WINTER DEMAND INITIATIVE FY-2025 FOR ELECTRICITY CONSUMERS ON INCREMENTAL CONSUMPTION FOR XWDISCOS AND K-ELECTRIC

1. This is with reference to the summary filed by MoE (Power Division) regarding winter demand initiative FY 2025, for industrial, domestic (ToU and non-ToU consumers exceeding 200 units), commercial and general services consumers of XW-DISCOS and K-Electric, which has been approved by ECC in its meeting held on 19.11.2024. The general provisions of the initiative are as under:

- Tariff of 26.07 Rs/kWh shall be charged to all eligible consumers on the respective incremental consumption, above the benchmark consumption in the corresponding months. The initiative shall remain applicable for a three-month billing period effective from December 2024 to February 2025. The benchmark consumption will be the higher of either the relevant month's consumption in FY 2024 or the historical consumption over the past 3 years for the relevant months, based on the formula provided. Other terms and conditions applicable to the initiative are also provided for reference. The initiative is subsidy neutral.

RECORDER REPORT KARACHI: Atif Ikram Sheikh, President FPCCI and Nasir Khan, VP FPCCI, (Balochistan) have expressed their profound grief and concerns of the entire business, industry and trade community of Pakistan on the kidnapping of a young boy in Quetta; loss of precious civilian and military lives in multiple terrorist attacks and other heinous crimes against humanity in Balochistan. That is the ultimate sacrifice and the business community salutes them for their courage, he added.

Atif Sheikh highlighted that these kinds of attacks on life and property cannot bring business, commercial, trade, investment, industrial and economic activities in the province to a halt. He added that small traders, cottage industries and micro, small & medium don't stand a chance to survive in these circumstances, if not given protection.
