


### TOTAL NATIONAL CONSUMPTION P&B PRODUCTS (M. TON)







#### **MARKET SHARE 2023-24**






#### **MARKET SHARE 2024-25**




#### **CAPACITY BREAK-UP**










#### **PRODUCTION (M.TONS)**

#### **SALES VOLUME (M. TONS)**









#### SALES, COGS & GP (RS' MLN)

#### **EBITDA (RS' MLN)**








#### **GROSS PROFIT VARIANCE WATERFALL (RS' MLN)**

FY2024/25 vs. FY2023/24




#### **DEBT EQUITY RATIO**






#### **DEBT SERVICING COVERAGE RATIO**
