The Department of Transport, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, under the special directives of the Secretary and Director Transport, has launched an effective province-wide crackdown against buses and vehicles emitting toxic and environmentally harmful smoke.

During the past two weeks, a total of 7,453 vehiweeks, a total of 7/8-3 vehi-des were inspected across the province. Out of these, 4,352 vehicles passed the emission test, while 3,301 drivers were fined and in-structed to obtain a Vehicle

The VETS Peshawar has also initiated a targeted inspection campaign against private school buses emitting excessive smoke. For this purpose, joint teams comprising officials from Vehicle Emission Testing Station (VETS) and the Motor Vehicle Examiner (MVE) are conducting daily inspections of school buses across various areas of Peshawar.

Through VETS' mobile
