China Manned Space Agency confirms Pakistani astronaut for 2026 flight

A Pakistani astronaut will join a short-term mission aboard the China Space Station in 2026 as a payload specialist, conducting scientific experiments on behalf of Pakistan, according to a statement issued on Friday by the China Manned Space Agency (CMSA). The announcement came as CMSA unveiled its 2026 spaceflight plans, which include two crewed missions and one cargo resupply flight to the orbiting station, according to a Gwadar Pro's report on Saturday. Astronauts from the Hong Kong and Macao Special Administrative Regions are also expected to participate in upcoming missions as China expands international cooperation in human spaceflight. Under the arrangement, the Pakistani astronaut will undertake a short-duration mission during a crew rotation period, serving as a payload specialist responsible for conducting scientific research and microgravity experiments. The

research will cover areas such as materials science, biological studies, and space technology applications, supporting Pakistan's growing interest in space science and innovation. The development follows an agreement signed between China and Pakistan in 2025 on the selection and training of Pakistani astronauts. The selection process for the Pakistani astronaut mission is progressing smoothly, according to the China Manned Space Engineering Office (CMSEO). CMSEO indicated that the Pakistani astronaut is expected to fly aboard a future Shenzhou mission for a short visit. During crew handovers, the station typically accommodates six astronauts for several days, allowing time for experiments, technical work, and outreach activities. The inclusion of a Pakistani astronaut marks a significant step in Pakistan-China strategic cooperation and makes Pakistan among a limited number of countries that have sent astronauts into space. Earlier, on February 12, China successfully launched Pakistan's PRSC-EO2 remote-sensing satellite along with six other satellites into orbit during an offshore mission in Guangdong province, further strengthening bilateral collaboration in satellite development, Earth observation, and space-based research.

Romanian Cultural Institute branches to mark Martisor tradition through various events

The Romanian Cultural Institute (ICR) will be marking the Romanian tradition of Martisor through events organised at its branches in Budapest, Stockholm and Vienna, according to the ICR Facebook page. The Romanian Cultural Institute in Vienna organises on Sunday, 1 March, between 15:00 and 18:00, the workshop 'Martisor, Romanian tradition and beauty,' an event dedicated to children of all ages, organised by volunteers of the Vienna Family Network. ICR Vienna and the Romanian Orthodox Church 'Descent of the Holy Spirit and Saint Stephen the Great' in the Austrian capital also organise a Martisor fair bringing together creations made by artisans of Romanian origin settled in this country.

The fair takes place on Friday between 15:00 and 19:00, on Saturday between 12:00 and 18:00 and on Sunday between 10:00 and 18:00, at Bruno-Marek-Allee 9, Vienna. The proposed activities include making Martisor tokens from various materials, creating cards dedicated to mothers and crafting bead bracelets on red thread. The event will also include a short presentation on the Martisor tradition, its meaning, origins and cultural context, delivered in Romanian with support in English or German. The Martisor tradition will also be celebrated in the Swedish capital on Friday from 16:30 through an event organised by ICR Stockholm together with the Embassies of Romania, the Republic of Moldova, Bulgaria and North Macedonia in the Kingdom of Sweden. At the ICR Stock-

holm headquarters, Martisor tokens from each participating country will be displayed and artisan Mihaela Bintia Alexe will demonstrate how a Romanian Martisor is made. During the event, films about the Martisor tradition in the four countries will be screened and guests will enjoy a folk dance performance by the Bulgarian group BG Folk Ritmi. The Seghedina branch of the Romanian Cultural Institute Budapest, in partnership with the 'Lucian Magdu' Romanian School in Battonya and the 'Lucian Magdu' Foundation, also known as the Romanian House in Battonya, organises the exhibition 'Martisor: UNESCO intangible cultural heritage,' designed to familiarise the public with the Martisor tradition.

Resident Evil Requiem's director on redefining the survival horror genre

LONDON (News Wire): Thirty years ago, a game named Resident Evil ushered in the survival horror genre - a blend of nerve-shredding tension, elaborate puzzles, and intricate inventory management. Neil Sedaka, singer of Breaking Up Is Hard To Do, dies at 86

American singer-songwriter Neil Sedaka, who wrote and performed hits through the 1950s and 60s, including Oh! Carol, Breaking Up Is Hard To Do, Bad Blood, Laughter in the Rain and Calendar Girl, has died at the age of 86. "Our family is devastated by the sudden passing of our beloved husband, father and grandfather," his family confirmed in a statement. "A true rock and roll legend, an inspiration



to millions, but most importantly, at least to those of us who were lucky enough to know him, an incredible human being who will be deeply missed." Sedaka, a skilled pianist nominated for five Grammy awards, also wrote hits for several other famous musicians in his six-decade-long career. His family did not disclose his cause of death or where he died. The Brooklyn native and student of the famed Julliard School in New York was a founder of the doo-wop group The Tokens in the late 1950s.

Oman is a preferred tourist destination during winter season

The winter tourism season in the Sultanate of Oman is delivering strong results this year, reflecting the country's growing appeal as a preferred destination for regional and international travelers. Stretching from October to April, the winter season has seen a noticeable rise in visitor numbers and hotel occupancy rates across the country. The surge has been driven by increased demand from domestic travelers, GCC markets and key European countries, particularly Germany, France and Italy. According to the Ministry of Heritage and Tourism, revenues of hotels classified between three and five stars grew by 22.2 percent in 2025, reaching OMR297.3 million. The number of visitors in this category exceeded 2.37 million, underscoring Oman's strengthening position as an integrated global tourism destination. Overall hotel guests reached 4.6 million, marking a 4.6 percent increase. Domestic tourism remains a cornerstone

of the sector's performance. In 2024, local visits climbed to 13.6 million, reflecting strong community engagement with Oman's tourism offerings and contributing significantly to the sustainability of the industry. The growth in demand has translated into improved operational and financial indicators. Experts noted increases in occupancy rates, higher average room prices and diversified revenue streams spanning leisure tourism, business travel and conferences. Hotel infrastructure has also expanded rapidly. The number of hotel establishments rose to 1,368 in 2025, compared to 1,022 in 2024, while total room capacity reached 38,390 — an 8.7 percent increase. The ministry issued 383 preliminary approvals for new projects, with 114 hotels currently under development and expected to open in 2026 and 2027. Investments in integrated tourism complexes have surpassed OMR11.5 billion, reflecting continued investor confidence in Oman's tourism market. In Al-Wusta Governorate, Saeed bin Masoud Al-Hanzali, Operations Manager at the Crowne Plaza Duqm, said the hotel recorded improved occupancy and revenue performance compared to last year. He attributed the growth to a balanced mix of business tourism and leisure travel from regional and European markets. In Muscat, Fahad bin Mohammed Al-Husseini, Director of Sales and Government Relations at The Chedi Muscat, reported occupancy rates exceeding 85 percent during the winter season. He credited international promotional campaigns, participation in tourism exhibitions and influencer marketing initiatives for attracting visitors from Europe, Russia and China.
