# Geelani's thoughts to serve as beacon of hope for Kashmiris: Mushaal

Special Assistant to the Prime Minister on Human Rights and Women Empowerment Mushaal Hussain Mullick on Friday paid glowing tributes to veteran Hurriyat leader Syed Ali Geelani, calling him a role model for the future generations. Addressing three different seminars in connection with the second death anniversary of great Hurriyat leader, Mullick said the late Geelani dedicated his entire life and sacrificed everything for the sacred cause of Kashmiri freedom struggle without budging an inch from his principled position till he breathed his last. Geelani's thoughts will continue to serve as beacon of hope for Kashmiris, Mushaal said. She stated that history testified that those who influenced human thoughts, their life was dedicated to some cause and they rendered sacrifices for freedom, always remained alive. Therefore, she said, personalities like Hazrat Baba Bulleh Shah and Syed Ali Geelani did not die and they just disappeared physically but their thoughts remained in the human minds. Geelani's thoughts will continue to serve as bea-

con of hope for Kashmiris: Mushaal Mushaal said Syed Ali Geelani embraced martyrdom under Indian police custody on September 1, 2021 at his residence in Hyderabad. Stringer. He was kept under continued illegal house arrest for over a decade by the Indian forces and it was now feared that a number of Hurriyat leaders, including Yasin Malik, were in queue to get the same fate like Geelani. Geelani's thoughts will continue to serve as beacon of hope for Kashmiris: Mushaal Therefore, she urged the United Nations bodies and the world powers to take cognizant of the inhuman acts by Indian occupation authorities and take urgent steps to ensure their safe release to avoid their custodial deaths. She said that Geelani gave his life in the struggle for independence of Kashmir, and exposed the fascist and oppressed face of India to the world, who dedicated his life and even his death to telling everybody that freedom could not be compromised or traded off. Ali Geelani did not die but just disappeared physically and his thoughts would continue to inspire the

Kashmiri freedom fighters and serve as a beacon of hope for the Kashmiri youth, she added. SAPM Mushaal said that the Indian government was afraid of Geelani's leadership abilities so much as manifested from the inhuman act after his physical death that the occupation forces had forcibly taken away his dead body for burial at the Hyderabad graveyard under heavy military guard at night in violation of the last will of the veteran leader. Mushaal highlighted that he was subjected to physical and mental torture during his imprisonment but never bowed down to the occupation forces till his last breath. He made a 'significant contribution to the Kashmiris' struggle for their right to self-determination and suffered lifelong persecution at the hands of India. She said that Geelani had foretold what the future beholds for Kashmir, as he had prophesied that when demography would be changed in favour of Hindus in Kashmir like in Jammu then India may concede to a plebiscite in the territory, fearing that the Modi regime may accept the plebiscite once its seilder plan was

accomplished. "Geelani was respected for the refinement of his personality, dedication and unwavering commitment to his mission that is why he won accolades from the people within and outside Kashmir, even by his critics and political adversaries," she maintained. Mushaal said that Pakistan conferred Nishan-i-Pakistan on Ali Geelani in recognition of his decades-old struggle for the Kashmiris' right to self-determination. She said that the Indian fascist occupation forces had been using the brutal, tyrannical and inhuman tactics to silence the dissenting powerful voices for the last seven decades but all their nefarious and notorious schemes proved exercise in futility rather their state terrorism further ignited the freedom struggle. She demanded that it was high time the notorious Indian government should release all the political prisoners instantly and let the Kashmiri people decide their fate as per their free will because it was proved that the fascist forces could not suppress the legitimate freedom struggle come what may. # 37 new dengue cases reported in Lahore

As many as 37 new dengue virus cases were reported in the provincial metropolis, on Friday. According to the Health department sources, besides the dengue virus cases, 1,185 larvae spots were reported in the last 24 hours, with many patients under treatment in different hospitals of the city. Various squads conducted surveillance at indoor and outdoor places to detect dengue larvae during the last 24 hours. The

anti-dengue squad destroyed dengue larvae at 1,185 places in the province during continuing surveillance. Sources said that on Friday, 37 new patients of dengue fever were reported in Lahore. It is worth mentioning here that more-over, 2,678 beds have been allocated for dengue patients in hospitals across Punjab, the Health department said. It may be mentioned here that Deputy Commissioner (DC) Lahore Rafiq Haider,

Additional Deputy Commissioners, and Assistant Commissioners are continuously paying surprise visits to check the performance of dengue teams working on the ground, in the wake of increasing dengue cases after rains. The DC reviewed the performance of dengue teams in various towns of Lahore. Checking of more than 5,000 places would be ensured on daily basis, she said. Meanwhile, in a statement issued

recently, Mr. Haider announced that the number of dengue surveillance could be increased, keeping in mind the rain alerts of the Meteorological department. Issuing directions for controlling dengue, she warned all town officers to strictly complete the set targets on a daily basis. She vowed to monitor various hotspots areas in the city with swift and strict surveillance, urging citizens to not let water accumulate in their homes and surroundings. aap

# Geelani's anniversary: Pakistan reaffirms support to people of Kashmir

Pakistan on Friday, while paying rich tribute to the life-long dedication of great Kashmiri leader Syed Ali Shah Geelani for justice and freedom, reaffirmed its support to the people of Indian Illegally Occupied Jammu & Kashmir (IOJK). Foreign Office Spokesperson Mumtaz Zahra Baloch, in her weekly press briefing, told the media that Syed Ali Shah Geelani, in his long and illustrious life, has been a symbol of the Kashmiris' struggle for their rights and freedom. "Today is the second death anniversary of the iconic Kashmiri leader, Syed Ali Shah Geelani. He breathed his last in a long-drawn house arrest on 01 September 2021. In a heroic act, his dead body was snatched by the Indian occupation forces from his family, and hurriedly buried in a graveyard in the absence of his family and friends. His family and friends were not allowed to pay their final respects or bury him in a graveyard of his choice," the spokesperson recalled.

She said the late Geelani's unflinching commitment to the Kashmiris' right to self-determination, in the face of persistent persecution and tremendous personal hardship, had inspired generations of Kashmiris in resisting the occupation and tyranny. Geelani would be remembered for his marvellous sacrifices and unconditional love for Kashmir and for Pakistan, she added. "Today, we pay rich tribute to his life-long dedication for justice and freedom, and reaffirm our support to the people of IOJK. We also urge the Government of India to give unhindered access to his family and followers to his final resting place," the spokesperson remarked.

To a question, she said Jammu and Kashmir was an internationally recognised disputed territory, whose final disposition was to be made in accordance with the United Nations resolutions and the wishes of the Kashmiri people. "Any other process cannot serve as a substitute to the grant of the right to self-determination of the Kashmiri people. Any other developments in IOJK will be observed and examined in Pakistan and we will give our reaction if there are any further developments. Pakistan's position is very consistent and clear that India must rescind its illegal acts of 5th August, 2019 and create an environment for peace and dialogue in the region." To another question, she said, "India has time and again, tried to project a false narrative of normalcy in IOJK by organizing different events. We believe that such stunts cannot legitimize India's occupation or suppress the true sentiments of the Kashmiri people. India's false facade of normalcy is challenged by the harsh reality that IOJK remains one of the most militarized zones in the world with extreme curbs on freedom of expression and assembly."
